

### Vision and Purpose



Charity established in 2014

- To have zero road deaths and serious injuries on UK roads
- To make UK roads safer by funding practical projects, research, dissemination and education





## How our grant funding works



Currently two rounds of funding available each year

- Small Grants programme
  - March each year

Funding rounds in 2023 are "open"

- Themed (Large) Grant programme
  - September/October each year



### Purpose of Grant Programme



- Generate new knowledge about what works
- Translate ideas into new measures
- Influence road safety policy and practice
- Support partnership working and collaboration



### **Autumn Grant round 2023**

Two routes:

**Small Grant strand** 

**Large Grant strand** 

Grant request is more than £20,000 but less than £50,000

Grant request is more than £50,000 but less than £500,000\*

**Small Grant** strand

**Large Grant** strand

\*Requests over £300,000 - Speak to the Grants Team before applying








### **Small Grants strand**



- Funding for local projects with a practical focus
- Focus on trialing, piloting and evaluating
- Innovation but not 'reinventing the wheel'
- Grants between £20,000 and £50,000
- Project length up to two years



### Large Grants strand



- Funding for research-based projects and the development, implementation and evaluation of innovative interventions
- Have a practical focus
- Must include plans for monitoring and evaluation of effectiveness
- Grants over £50,000 and up to £500,000
   Requests £300,000-500,000 contact us before applying
- Project length up to three years





### Who can apply



### UK based organisations:

- Local public sector organisations (e.g. local authority, road safety partnership or police and fire and rescue service)
- Charities
- Not-for-profit, social enterprise or Community Interest Companies
- Universities

# Tips for your grant application







Go to the 'Grants' section of our website and download the useful documents for each strand

There is a Large Grants page and Small Grants page



## Tip: Writing your application



- Clear aims and objectives
- Explain the road safety benefits and how you will measure them
- All projects should involve partnership working and strong project management
- Show the routes to road safety practice and policy, achieving impact and making a difference

Application process goes into more detail for the Large Grants



### Tip: Eligible costs



#### DO INCLUDE

- A well costed budget in your application
- Other sources of funding cash or in-kind
- Only project costs
- Monitoring & evaluation and dissemination costs (including evaluation training)

### DON'T INCLUDE

- Core costs or organisation running costs
- Overheads and indirect costs (including elsewhere such as in salary costs)
- Enforcement equipment or signage costs for standard road safety operations
- Police officer salaries or overtime



## Tip: Sharing what you have learnt and produced



- Plans to share learning and any outputs produced by the project
  - ALL results are important!
- Final project report shared on our website and available on the RSGB Knowledge Centre
- RSGB National Road Safety Conference
  - This is a great way to tell others in the sector about your project

### How and when can I apply?



- Online portal open from 4 October link via our website
  - Paper or emailed applications are not accepted
- New applicants register and set up an account
- Complete a short eligibility quiz automatic direction to correct application form for the strand
- Portal closes on 7 November at 5pm
- Final decisions by January 2024 for Small Grants and February 2024 for Large Grants
